boards, Kurzanski used digital painting to color the panels. He chose a different art style for each of the four stories, to make the stories visually distinct from one another.

The result is a 22-page publication called *Life Has a Limit with a Cigarette in It* that is being used in New York City schools, afterschool programs, and community centers to show the dangers of tobacco use. In addition to the four stories, the comic book has original word games, puzzles, letters to the editor, and public service announcements. All were written by students who participated in The Comic Book Project, and all the contributors are credited for their work.

## **Looking Back**

Through their creations, the students are helping their peers to appreciate the dangers of smoking. They themselves also came to appreciate that words and drawings are a very good way to convey an important message to a lot of people. Sarah, who also writes poetry and is considering a career as a writer or teacher, discovered that "authors write things that help in everyday life" and that "there can be complex things in comic books."

How does it feel to become a published author while still in middle school? Says Tracey Louie: "It's awesome that a real book could be done by kids." Her sister Jennifer says she feels "like a miniature celebrity." Sarah laughingly reports that a fellow student asked for her autograph and admits that "it's fun hearing that people like what you wrote."

How do the students feel about knowing that their anti-smoking messages will be read by other kids? Says Sarah, "The best part is the chance to work with others to help prevent something that's bad." "It's good to help," adds Julia.

Some of these students may be on the way to writing careers. But they definitely are not on the way to careers as smokers. Would they ever consider smoking? The answer was a resounding "No!" from all.



- Make sketches that show which characters appear in each panel, what they are saying, and what is happening.
- 7. Make pencil drawings.
- 8. Ink the pencil drawings.
- Add lettering, first in pencil and then in ink.

Also, he is a good thinker, because the book says, "The author of this fatal trick was Ulysses, sharpest tactician among the invaders." (Evslin, p.xi) Ulysses was also strong, because he was able to bend the bow back, which none of the 100 suitors could. He was also able to stay awake for a really long time. The book said, "And for 9 days and 9 nights, Ulysses did not sleep..." (Evslin, p.35) Ulysses, was also favored by certain god and goddess like Athena and Hermes. Athena helped him by telling Zeus that Ulysses had paid his debt to Poseidon. "He has paid for his eye over and over again, cried Athena."
